	<p>Endorsement of the general Green Mobility Declaration including Clean Bus and Clean Fleet Platform, Cycling Declaration of South East European Parties and Observing Participants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Declaration for Green Mobility of South East European Parties and Observing Participants, pledges to promote zero-emission and smart mobility, enhance climate resilience in transport networks, and foster regional cooperation for sustainable transport solutions. Annexes of the Declaration are: • The Clean Bus and Fleet Platform aims to address challenges posed by traditional fossil fuel-powered buses and fleets, promoting adoption of clean energy and technologies, infrastructure development, collaborative partnerships, incentives and funding, data transparency, and a comprehensive approach integrating clean vehicle technologies into urban logistics and government fleets. • The Declaration on Cycling promotes cycling for a healthier, more equitable, and environmentally friendly society. It includes pledges to develop policies, invest in infrastructure, improve safety, educate, reduce emissions, promote partnerships, collect data, prioritize inclusivity, and collaborate internationally to advance cycling regionally.
