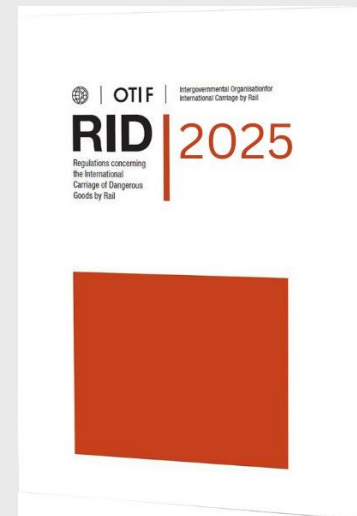

Recommendations

- The region should prioritise **emergency preparedness** for emergencies involving chemicals, biologic, and radio-nuclear threats.
- Ministries of Transport should prioritise **cooperation** with the Ministries of Interior.
- Translate the annexes of Directive 2008/68/EC as amended (i.e. ADR, RID and ADN 2025)
- Continue work of **implementation of Directive 2022/1999**.
- Be active in **follow-up of peer reviews**.
- **Build national priorities lists** based on the reports of the experts.
- Invest in **human resources** and their protection.
